

# Spiritual Gifts

How it all fits together

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## Overview

I used to think that our actions were all based on our paradigms. This is true in part. I have since discovered that the spiritual gifts that we are born with are the true commanders of our lives. Our paradigms are what dictates how we use our spiritual gifts. Or why and how we bury and hide them.

Having researched and studied spiritual gifts for many years along with what I could study of gifts of the chakras I was able to pull some shards of knowledge together. The reasons behind knowing the gifts of the chakras, spiritual gifts, and the names of God all coalesced into a beautiful blue print of how to become a more empowered human being.

I still do not understand many things but I do know that becoming more like God/Allah/Jesus is a very good thing. When one actively pursues enhancing the gifts one is born with and acquiring more spiritual gifts one becomes more like God. This is why (some of) God's names are used-so we can become more like Him.

Have you ever wondered why, if we are truly sons and daughters of the Most High God, that He is omnipotent and we can hardly do anything? I believe its because He has full use of all spiritual gifts and our number of gifts and their uses are severely limited.

Would I be so bold as to suggest that God Almighty has spiritual gifts? Of course He does! Where else would ours come from?! This is a clear tether linking our potentials to our Heavenly Creator who created us.

*Psalm 8:5 For thou hast made him (mankind) a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. ~ Old Testament (KJV)*

*John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. New testament (KJV)*

The gifts we inherit come to us effortlessly, are used easily, and with little to no thought of using them. Yes, they are inherited through family lines from our ancestors. This is one reason why one family is gifted musically and another family "can't hold a tune in a bucket."

Now, to put it in today's terms. To compare us humans to a computer. We are born with out-of-the-box functionality. With our 'mother board' we can breath, think, move, make sound, have five senses, and a functioning digestive tract. The spiritual gifts add functionality to the mother board. They are the apps, extensions, widgets, and plugins. The more you have the better you function and the more you can do. This is personal power or empowerment.

We are each also a do-it-yourself kit. Meaning that everything that needs to be, or can be, added are things we can add ourselves. It takes some work. For some things it takes some skill. Yet everything can be done without anyone else helping us other than the dissemination of information. Once you

know how to install a plugin you can do it yourself. Further, no one else can do it for you. That makes it free will. If there is something you don't want you certainly don't have to have it.

Some applications (apps) are installed by our manufacturers, our parents. These are our inherited spiritual gifts. They have varying strengths and additional plugins for them as well. We can add to them. If we don't use them over time they will eventually go to sleep. Yet even then they are still present and accessible if we choose to start using them. Simply start using them and they come back online.

The spiritual gifts or gifts of the chakras can be looked at like a cms or content management system website. Each chakra is a category in which the gifts reside. There are certain gifts that have to do with family and community. These reside in the root chakra.

There are links in other chakras that create connection to the root chakra and so can influence the root chakra's category information from other locations. This is a long way of saying that everything is connected.

This basic categorization was found out by many hundreds of years of observations by those of the Asiatic persuasion. The people of the Eastern countries have had a knowledge of this for thousands of years. Because of this we use their words and terms for things that they have examined and understand to a science. These Eastern peoples have had hundreds to thousands of years to figure out how to work with this cms. Why we of the West are taking so long to access that information is a mystery.

I have seen spiritual gifts defined as 'supernatural abilities.' I don't think they are supernatural. I think they are simply abilities that require a different fuel source. The ability to play piano, for instance, takes talent and practice. The fuel source for this is food and water.

The ability for remote viewing has instead a fuel source of spirit energy. It is the dependence on spirit energy that makes them *spiritual* gifts. The stronger the spirit energy the stronger the gift. In the holy writings the stronger energy is written with a capital 'S'. That is why it is written 'Spirit'. This is also why righteousness is a factor in their acquisition and use. Righteousness allows for the Spirit to be present in strength.

Wickedness dampens spirit energy. Coffee doesn't help. The wicked Lamanites had the same inherited spiritual gifts as the righteous Nephites. The righteous Nephites could always beat them in battle because they had the increased Spirit fuel to whup 'em. When the Nephites were wicked they had the same spirit energy level and then it was a contest of wills and numbers. When the Lamanites were more righteous then the Nephites the Lamanites won the battles. Then the Lamanites had the Spirit with them. Doesn't it make sense that the greatest amount of the Spirit would be when connected to the Maker Of All Energy? See appendix.

I personally believe that people have a minimum of seven gifts. One main gift for each chakra. There is a list included with a brief description of what each chakra governs. Being able to name the gift gives one an advantage. One now has the ability to target what it is one wants to gain or strengthen. This gives the ability to have focused prayers, fasting, intoning, or what ever other method one may know of and desire to use. This gives us the ‘*what*’ of spiritual gifts.

Some people have experienced strong negativity concerning their spiritual gifts. This sometimes causes people to stop using them. Some people can have a very easy life (I wouldn’t know one but it happens). This can cause people to never find out what it is they have as a “super power.”

In order to do anything with them we need a ***method*** to achieve whatever goals we may have pertaining to them. There are two methods I have found. One is by much fasting and much prayer. The second is by daily recitation, intoning, wazifa of the names of God that pertain to what one is seeking to enhance or gain. Both of these methods work. This is the “*how*.”

It is said that when one is seeking enlightenment (I have no idea what that means) by intonation that gifts of the chakras come spontaneously. That these spontaneously acquired gifts are considered a nuisance. I am thinking that there is no way they could not show up. They would have to since they are using the method to gain them.

We also need a ‘*why*’ for enhancing or gaining spiritual gifts. These gifts are how God empowers His children, us. We are to use our gifts for three purposes: 1) to help us through our lives of toil and tribulation; 2) to help our neighbors through life; and 3) to use to bring people to Jesus Christ. Examples will come later.

If you decide to work with what I have included here just keep these things in mind.

1. Your focus determines your reality.
2. Breath in what you want and breath out what you don’t want. (fasting & prayer, wazifa, mantra, etc.)
3. Pick a method and stick with it. You’ll go far.

## **Three-fold purposes of spiritual gifts**

### **1) To help us through our lives of toil and tribulation**

We reflexively and instinctively use our spiritual gifts. They have always been with us. This is why they are so hard to recognize sometimes. A fish in the water does not know what 'wet' is. How conscious are we through the day of how continual our breathing is? That there is air around us?

This is one purpose for the hardships we encounter in life-to help us utilize and recognize our gifts. To use an extreme example: The gift of being able to overcome poison. Unless someone tries to poison you or you accidentally ingest poison, and you live through it, you will never know you have that gift. So one of your trials in life will likely involve a poisoning somehow and you over coming it.

### **2) To help our neighbors through life**

Another extreme example: If one has the gift of being able to overcome ones enemies then it can show up in various ways. Not only would one be able to win in a fight, but also if one is in the front of a battle then the battle may be sure to be won for one's whole army. One has thus helped to keep ones neighbors alive.

### **3) To use to bring people to Jesus Christ**

If one has the gift of teaching knowledge then one can teach people about Jesus. That way the people will learn of Him and be more enticed to turn to Him.

These are just a few uses of gifts. There are as many uses as there are people to use them. Even when two people have the same gift they may present them differently. There are an unlimited number of combinations of gifts and their uses. Of course there are. God is unlimited and we are His children.

Now to expound a bit...

### **3) To use to bring people to Jesus Christ**

Now that we have gone over the whole picture of what spiritual gifts are, how to get more, and what to do with them, I would like to elaborate on the third use of spiritual gifts. I will use the Book of Mormon to illustrate. Lets use Nephi and his descendants.

Nephi had two certain spiritual gifts that transferred on down his descendants line. These two gifts were 1) overcoming their enemies, and 2) that they would prosper in the land when they were righteous. These are specifically stated in Alma:

Book of Mormon Alma 48:15-16; 15 And this was their faith, that by so doing God would prosper them in the land, or in other words, if they were faithful in keeping the commandments of God that he would prosper them in the land; yea, warn them to flee, or to prepare for war, according to their danger;

16 And also, that God would make it known unto them whither they should go to defend themselves against their enemies, and by so doing, the Lord would deliver them;...

We can see that Nephi inherited these gifts from his father, Lehi. Lehi was warned in a dream to flee Jerusalem to save his life. Lehi fled and stayed alive also keeping his family alive (1 Nephi 2:1-2). The people of Jerusalem were killing the prophets and Lehi was a prophet. So gift two is demonstrated in two generations. (1 Nephi 3:29; 1 Nephi 7:17) (2 Nephi 5:4-5)

When Nephi and his brothers were sent back to get the brass plates they tried to buy them from Laban with their much gold, silver, and riches (1 Nephi 3:17). This shows that the righteous prophet, Lehi, was prospering in the land. Nephi is given the promised land (1 Nephi 2:20; 2 Nephi 5:11). Gift one is demonstrated.

The descendants of Nephi were chosen to be their kings because of those two gifts. When the righteous king prospered all the people prospered. When the righteous king went to battle against their enemies they would win their battles. Sometimes by a wide margin. At one point their enemies, the Lamanites, were scared to go to battle against them because they had so much power to win. (Alma 47:2)

Let's fast forward to king Mosiah, a direct descendant of Nephi. He had a prosperous and mostly war free reign. He had four sons. These sons, also having those same two spiritual gifts, made a plan. They decided to go on a mission for Jesus among their enemies, the Lamanites. They didn't decide this lightly or on blind faith. They set their focus and deliberately employed those same two spiritual gifts.

The Lamanites would kill a Nephite as soon as they saw one. They hated the Nephites. Mosiah knew this and so asked the Lord about the situation. The Lord assured them that their gift of overcoming their enemies was in place and they would not be killed. (Mosiah 28:6-7)

The four sons of Mosiah set their focus on overcoming their enemies in the form of not being killed when they went into Lamanite territory. This instead of winning in a fight against their enemies. In fact it could be said that they overcame their enemies with love. The converts loved the sons of Mosiah and looked upon them as saving angels. (Alma 27:4) They overcame with love instead of swords.

They set their focus of prospering in the land. The prosperity they sought was converts to Jesus Christ.

With their focus and intentions set they walked into Lamanite territory and achieved what they intentionally set out to gain. They stayed alive and gained *thousands* of converts. What an amazing prosperity! They didn't seek gold and silver and precious things as the other Nephites had done. They

sought to prosper *in converts* and got them in seven lands by full cognizant intention and focus. (Alma 23:3-6, 8-13)

The Book of Mormon says that they had a few other hand picked Nephites that went with them. I can guarantee you that those others were also direct descendants of Nephi (or his brothers) with the same two spiritual gifts.

(Mosiah 28:1)

Now if those two unlikely gifts can be used to bring people to Jesus Christ then *any gift* can be used to do so. In fact *every gift* can be used to bring people to Jesus. It's a matter of knowing what the gifts are, setting focus and intention, then taking prayerful action. Every one has at least one gift they can use to bring people to Jesus. Probably two.

## **2) To help our neighbors through life**

Let us now elaborate on another use of spiritual gifts. It is well known concerning the righteous-wickedness-righteous cycle of the Nephites in the Book of Mormon. The reason for this cycle was pride. The people when humbled would call upon Jesus and repent of their wickedness. The Lord would immediately bless them with prosperity. They would gather to themselves gold and silver and precious things. Then they would set their hearts upon their riches and go wicked again and loose everything or end up in battles.

In order to avoid this cycle I would suggest that instead of desiring these things of themselves, they instead could desire them for their neighbors and not themselves. This would raise all the people up equally and there would be no poor among them. (Alma 1:27)

Not all Nephites were direct descendants of Nephi and so they did not all share those same two aforementioned gifts. That's why they had poor among them. Only the ones who had the specific gift of prospering when righteous would do so. Other people could be more righteous and still not prosper in the land. It's a very specific gift.

## **1) To help us through our lives of toil and tribulation.**

It is a good idea to be able to use ones own spiritual gifts to keep oneself afloat financially, physically, spiritually, and in all other ways. That having been said it is also a good idea to be self-sufficient at least so that you are not being a pull on others resources. It takes work to employ spiritual gifts and if one is self-sustaining then one can be a contributor to the dissemination of the blessings that gifts can deliver.

At least be self-sustaining. For some people this is the best they can do. That's all right. If that's not all right with you than maybe its time to add in a few more spiritual gifts! You can.

***Do not put your light under a bushel ~ Sharing your spiritual gifts!***

Book of Mormon, 3 Nephi 3:19

19 Now it was the custom among all the Nephites to appoint for their chief captains, (save it were in their times of wickedness) some one that had the spirit of revelation and also prophecy; therefore, this Gidgiddoni was a great prophet among them, as also was the chief judge.

So how did the people know who had what gift? The ones with the gifts told them. This is how they spoke of their gifts:

Book of Mormon, 2 Nephi 1:6 I, Lehi, prophecy according to the workings of the Spirit *which is in me*,

2 Nephi 25:4, But I give unto you a prophecy, according to the spirit *which is in me*;

Alma 61:15 the spirit of freedom *which is in them*.

Alma 26:13 because of the power of his word *which is in us*.

Alma 14:10 and exercise the power of God *which is in us*

Alma 7:5 according to the Spirit of God *which is in me*,

Words of Mormon 1:7 according to the workings of the Spirit of the Lord *which is in me*.

Alma 5:46 this is the spirit of revelation *which is in me*.

Jacob 4:15 I, Jacob, am led on by the Spirit unto prophesying; ...*which is in me*,

Alma 45:10 according to the spirit of revelation *which is in me*,

## **Fasting and Prayer**

- ✓ It is said that the only wrong way to pray is to not pray at all.
- ✓ Fasting has scientifically provable results.
- ✓ When one puts these two together miracles happen!

The four sons of Mosiah added prophecy and revelation to their tool box of gifts. (Alma 17:3) See appendix for full scriptural contents.

In the Old Testament, Isaiah 58:6-12 (3 Nephi 13:16-18) it enumerates what can be accomplished by fasting with prayer.

- **The Fast God Has Chosen:**

- Loose the bands of wickedness. Undo the heavy burdens. Let the oppressed go free. Break every yoke.

- **Caring for Others:**

- Deal your bread to the hungry. Bring the poor and cast out to your house. Cover the naked when you see them. Don't hide yourself from your own flesh.

- **Blessings for Righteous Actions:**

- Your light shall break forth as the morning. Your health shall spring forth speedily. Your righteousness will go before you. The glory of the Lord shall be your rearward.

- **God's Response:**

- When you call, the Lord shall answer. When you cry, He will say, "Here I am." Take away the yoke, pointing fingers, and speaking vanity.

### **An instance of a very specific time of intense fasting and prayer-**

Mosiah 27:21-23:

Alma's (dad) friends, including priests, fast and pray for two days and nights. They pray that Alma's (son) mouth would be opened to speak and that his strength would be restored. After their prayers, Alma's strength returns, and he stands up to comfort the people, encouraging them to be of good comfort.

Mighty prayer is in Enos 1:4; whole book.

Helaman 3:35 ... fast and pray oft, (gained)...humility, ... faith, ...pure hearts

## **Why!**

This is what everything on this earth is about and this is why we are here. ***Our spiritual gifts help us to help Jesus achieve His end result.*** What is His end result? Here are Jesus' own statements.

### **Jesus' Purpose Statement**

Pearl of Great Price, Moses 1:39 **For behold, this is my work and my glory—to bring to pass the immortality and eternal life of man.**

### **Jesus' Mission Statement**

What is his *method* for doing this? It is what we call the Gospel of Jesus Christ as follows.

#### **Summary:**

In **3 Nephi 27:13-22**, Jesus explains that He came to do the will of the Father, including being crucified to draw all men to Him. He teaches that those who repent, are baptized in His name, and endure to the end will be forgiven and saved. Those who do not endure will be cast away. No unclean thing can enter His kingdom, and only those who are cleansed through His atonement, faith, and repentance can be saved. He commands all to repent, be baptized, and receive the Holy Ghost to be sanctified and stand before Him spotless at the last day.

## Catagories

1. **Root Chakra:** Grounding, stability, family, foundations, and security.
2. **Sacral Chakra:** Creativity, how we experience and express emotions, and sexual vitality.
3. **Solar Plexus/Naval Chakra:** Confidence, personal power, and willpower.
4. **Heart Chakra:** Love, compassion, and emotional healing.
5. **Throat Chakra:** Communication, self-expression, and truth-telling.
6. **Third Eye Chakra:** Intuition, insight, and spiritual perception.
7. **Crown Chakra:** Spiritual connection, enlightenment, and oneness with the divine.

The word 'chakra' simply means 'wheel.' See appendix.

**Root Chakra: Catagory 1:** Grounding, stability, family, foundations, and security. Examples:

1. ability to jump long distances, almost similar to flying (*Darduri siddhi*)
2. ability to transcend time - present, past and future (*Trikala jnana*)
3. control over the elements of the earth - becoming air, flesh, water, etc.
4. to slow down ageing and live long (*Kayakalpa siddhi*)

**Sacral Chakra: Catagory 2:** Creativity, how we experience and express emotions, and sexual vitality.

Examples:

1. freedom from enemies
2. the status of a lord among yogis
3. eloquence in speech
4. clarity in thinking
5. being unafraid of water
6. affinity with astral entities
7. ability to manifest desires

**Solar Plexus Chakra: Catagory 3:** Confidence, personal power, and willpower. Examples:

1. center of self-assertion
2. effectively dominate situations and other people
3. effectively manipulate the world according to personal wishes

**Heart Chakra(s): Catagory 4:** Love, compassion, and emotional healing. Examples:

1. becomes capable of protection and destruction
2. he can enter other people's bodies at will
3. he can leave and enter the body at will
4. radiant splendor
5. capable of experiencing infinite joy and pain
6. seat of the thinking mind.



**Throat Chakra: Catagory 5:** Communication, self-expression, and truth-telling. Examples:

1. revelation of nature's secrets - repeating patterns of life are revealed, hidden natural laws are learned,
2. knowing (*being in the*) past, present and future – all time is “now”
3. communication - vishuddhi chakra is the centre of speech. One begins to articulate complex ideas into a cohesive, elegant and fluid verbal narrative
4. enhancement of artistic virtues - musical and poetic abilities are enhanced
5. attraction by ganas (*disembodied beings*) - ganas are distorted entities, looking very different from humans. They have limbs without bones coming out of odd parts of their bodies. Although they may look hideous, a person with an activated vishuddhi will not be frightened of these beings. It is said that Shiva prefers the company of ganas more than anyone else
6. freedom from disease and old age
7. destruction of dangers - the universe looks after your well being

**Third Eye Chakra: Catagory 6:** Intuition, insight, and spiritual perception. Examples:

1. knowledge and wisdom are attained
2. past karma is forgiven
3. destruction of karma (from past lives)
4. able to be in a continuous state of samadhi (realized non-duality)
5. visions of past, present and future
6. desires come true
7. internal and external changes cease to be a problem
8. seeing all events on the planet without moving

“I think this (third eye) is where most evolved people (*gurus, swamis, sensei, etc*) get stuck. When they realize a certain **power** (*miracles, turning water into wine, walking on water, producing ash from thin air, etc.*) and can attract a following, it becomes intoxicating - people give you money, women (want you), intellectuals abandon critical thinking, zealots beg you to command them. The **ego is god-dified** and the progression on the path comes to a screeching halt. **Crown Chakra: Catagory 7:** Spiritual connection, enlightenment, and oneness with the divine.

Examples:

1. Achieve enlightenment
2. Achieving highest state of spiritual bliss and self-realization (nirbiji samadhi)
3. Raising Shakti kundalini to the level of brahmarandhra (fontanel) / Completion of the union between energy (Shakti kundalini) and awareness (Shiva kundalini)

The crown chakra has the “thousand petaled lotus”. Because of this I say that there are over a thousand more spiritual gifts. There are also exponential combinations of gifts and how they manifest. Evenso, this list is sufficient to get one started in focused acquisition of additional gifts to use to serve humanity.

22 And he caused that the priests should assemble themselves together; and they began to fast, and to pray to the Lord their God that he would open the mouth of Alma, that he might speak, and also that his limbs might receive their strength—that the eyes of the people might be opened to see and know of the goodness and glory of God.

23 And it came to pass after they had fasted and prayed for the space of two days and two nights, the limbs of Alma received their strength, and he stood up and began to speak unto them, bidding them to be of good comfort:

Enos' mighty prayer:

Book of Mormon, Enos 1:4 (and all of Enos)

4 And my soul hungered; and I kneeled down before my Maker, and I cried unto him in mighty prayer and supplication for mine own soul; and all the day long did I cry unto him; yea, and when the night came I did still raise my voice high that it reached the heavens.

Book of Mormon, Helaman 3:35

35 Nevertheless they did fast and pray oft, and did wax stronger and stronger in their humility, and firmer and firmer in the faith of Christ, unto the filling their souls with joy and consolation, yea, even to the purifying and the sanctification of their hearts, which sanctification cometh because of their yielding their hearts unto God.

### **Jesus' Mission Statement**

And what is His *method* for doing this? It is what we call the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In **3 Nephi 27:13-22**, when Jesus refers to being "saved," He is talking about **salvation from sin and death**. Specifically, being saved means:

1. **Forgiveness of Sins:** Through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ, a person is forgiven of their sins.

2. **Eternal Life:** Salvation also refers to receiving **eternal life** with God, which is made possible by Jesus' atonement and resurrection.
3. **Freedom from Spiritual Death:** Being saved means being freed from **spiritual death**, which is *separation from God*, and being able to return to His presence if they remain faithful.

So, when Jesus says those who repent, are baptized, and endure to the end will be "saved," He is saying they will be forgiven, receive eternal life, and be able to stand before God clean and righteous at the final judgment.

### **Jesus' own full mission statement- The Gospel of Jesus Christ**

Book of Mormon, 3 Nephi 27:13-22

13 Behold I have given unto you my gospel, and this is the gospel which I have given unto you—that I came into the world to do the will of my Father, because my Father sent me.

14 And my Father sent me that I might be lifted up upon the cross; and after that I had been lifted up upon the cross, that I might draw all men unto me, that as I have been lifted up by men even so should men be lifted up by the Father, to stand before me, to be judged of their works, whether they be good or whether they be evil—

15 And for this cause have I been lifted up; therefore, according to the power of the Father I will draw all men unto me, that they may be judged according to their works.

16 And it shall come to pass, that whoso repenteth and is baptized in my name shall be filled; and if he endureth to the end, behold, him will I hold guiltless before my Father at that day when I shall stand to judge the world.

## Our Work

### **Parable of the sheep and the goats**

Matthew 25:31-40

31 ¶ When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:

33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

35 *For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in:*

36 *Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.*

37 Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungred, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink?

31 And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.

32 And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.

33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,

34 And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.

35 And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

### **Parable of the Talents**

New Testament Matthew 25:14-30

14 ¶ For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.

17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.

18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:

25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

26 His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:

27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.

28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.

29 For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.

## **People Who Lived Right**

Mosiah 4:21 ... O then, how ye ought to impart of the substance that ye have one to another.

Mosiah 4:26-27 26 ...I would that ye should impart of your substance to the poor, every man according to that which he hath, such as feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and administering to their relief, both spiritually and temporally, according to their wants.

27 And see that all these things are done in wisdom and order;

Mosiah 18:27 And again Alma commanded that the people of the church should impart of their substance, every one according to that which he had; if he have more abundantly he should impart more abundantly;

Alma 8:20 Therefore, go with me into my house and I will impart unto thee of my food;

Alma 4:13 while others were abasing themselves, succoring those who stood in need of their succor, such as imparting their substance to the poor and the needy, feeding the hungry, and suffering all manner of afflictions, for Christ's sake,

Pearl of Great Price, Moses 7:18 And the Lord called his people Zion, because they were of one heart and one mind, and dwelt in righteousness; and there was no poor among them.

4 Nephi 1:3 And they had all things common among them; therefore there were not rich and poor, bond and free, but they were all made free, and partakers of the heavenly gift.

### **'S'pirit vs 's'pirit**

Christians like to think that only Christians can have spiritual gifts. Not so. These gifts have been around longer than Christianity. The ancient texts of India, China, Japan, etc. Are full of accounts of people exhibiting extreme abilities. I believe it's India (not sure of the country-could be China) that has a record of two armies doing battle with each other in the sky.

The movies 'Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon' and 'A Wrinkle in Time' show 'super powers' that are commonly known among Asiatic countries. This shows that it is not a matter of worship per se, as much as a matter of getting ones spiritual energy to high levels. The magicians of pharaoh's court had this knowledge. That is why the magicians could do everything Moses could do. However Moses was more righteous and had God on his side. This is why he could out perform the magicians. Moses' snake ate the magician's snakes. In Jedi terms, it's the ability to call upon the Force that makes the difference. (There really were Djedi in Egypt. Search Dr. Robert Gilbert.) This subject isn't new.

Worshipping God is the fastest and best way to get spirit energy to high levels of **Spirit** energy. In fact it is shown that God-Spirit energy is the strongest energy of all. Ergo Moses defeating the magicians and Nephites winning battles by a landslide. Here are some verses that demonstrate this.

**Moses:**

Old Testament, Exodus 7:12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. (Magic and sorcery are Satan's counterfeits for Spiritual personal power.)

**Nephites:**

Righteous Nephites:Wicked Lamanites ~ Alma 47:2 And it came to pass that when the proclamation had gone forth among them they were exceedingly afraid; yea, they feared to displease the king, and they also *feared to go to battle against the Nephites lest they should lose their lives*. And it came to pass that they would not, or the more part of them would not, obey the commandments of the king.

3 Nephi 4:8-14 8 And it came to pass that the armies of the Nephites, when they saw the appearance of the army of Giddianhi, *had all fallen to the earth, and did lift their cries to the Lord their God, that he would spare them and deliver them out of the hands of their enemies*.

Here the Nephites are deliberately invoking greater strength- calling in the 'S' Spirit super power- that they are entitled to from having that overcome-your-enemies spiritual gift. They are consciously connecting with the God-Spirit energy. Every spiritual gift you have and can get can be strengthened this way and this quickly. (Morning prayer can charge up your gifts for the day!)

9 And it came to pass that when the armies of Giddianhi saw this they began to shout with a loud voice, because of their joy, for they had supposed that the Nephites had fallen with fear because of the terror of their armies.

10 But in this thing they were disappointed, for the Nephites did not fear them; but they did fear their God and did supplicate him for protection; therefore, when the armies of Giddianhi did rush upon them they were prepared to meet them; yea, **in the strength of the Lord** they did receive them.

11 And the battle commenced in this the sixth month; and great and terrible was the battle thereof, yea, great and terrible was the slaughter thereof, insomuch that there never was known so great a slaughter among all the people of Lehi since he left Jerusalem.

12 And notwithstanding the threatenings and the oaths which Giddianhi had made, behold, *the Nephites did beat them*, insomuch that they did fall back from before them.

13 And it came to pass that Gidgiddoni commanded that his armies should pursue them as far as the borders of the wilderness, and that they should not spare any that should fall into their hands by the way; and thus they did pursue them and did slay them, to the borders of the wilderness, even until they had fulfilled the commandment of Gidgiddoni.

14 And it came to pass that Giddianhi, who had stood and fought with boldness, was pursued as he fled; and being weary because of his much fighting he was overtaken and slain.

Both wicked ~ Book of Mormon, Helaman 4:23-25 23 And because of their iniquity the church had begun to dwindle; and they began to disbelieve in the spirit of prophecy and in the spirit of revelation; and the judgments of God did stare them in the face.

24 And they saw that they had become weak, like unto their brethren, the Lamanites, and that the Spirit of the Lord did no more preserve them; yea, it had withdrawn from them because the Spirit of the Lord doth not dwell in unholy temples—

25 Therefore the Lord did cease to preserve them by his miraculous and matchless power, for they had fallen into a state of unbelief and awful wickedness; and they saw that the Lamanites were exceedingly more numerous than they, and except they should cleave unto the Lord their God they must unavoidably perish.

26 For behold, they saw that the strength of the Lamanites was as great as their strength, even man for man. And thus had they fallen into this great transgression; yea, thus had they become weak, because of their transgression, in the space of not many years.

Righteous Lamanites:Wicked Nephites ~ Samuel the Lamanite - Helaman 13:1 And now it came to pass in the eighty and sixth year, the Nephites did still remain in wickedness, yea, in great wickedness, while the Lamanites did observe strictly to keep the commandments of God, according to the law of Moses.

Helaman 16:2 But as many as there were who did not believe in the words of Samuel were angry with him; and they cast stones at him upon the wall, and also many shot arrows at him as he stood upon the wall; *but the **Spirit** of the Lord was with him, insomuch that they could not hit him with their stones neither with their arrows.*

Both Righteous ~ 4 Nephi 1:3 And they had all things common among them; therefore there were not rich and poor, bond and free, but they were all made free, and partakers of the heavenly gift. (see John 4:10)

To use “Al-”, “An-”, “Ad-”, “Ar-”, “As-”, “Ya”, etc., as a prefix makes no difference in English. I use “Ya” as a standard. However, since they do come from a precise language, it would be good to use them. They all mean “Oh” as in calling to a divine source. It’s to draw attention like calling “Hey! You! I’m over here!”

Everywhere I found this list on the internet they were numbered in the same order. I kept that order. Pronunciations and variants in spelling (since they are not in English originally) can be found on the Internet. Along with these are how to do wazifa, intonation, and other focus methods. How to fast and pray to gain something good is also had on the internet. Many people already have knowledge of these even if they have not used them.

Any one of these names has several meanings and meaningful applications. As you can see, there are often instances where there is not a direct correlation between the names of God and a given spiritual gift. This is where knowledge of the deeper and extended meanings of the names becomes important. I assure you that you will always find a name or combination of names that will fit a gift if you study them.

There is a Jewish list of 72 names of God and Biblical Christians list of 77 Names of God. Same concept only it’s fewer names. You can use those lists instead. There is a lot of overlap. See appendix.

One can use prayer, a pendulum, dowsing, or other method to determine which one or combinations of names to use at any given time. Generally the names chosen are focused on daily for three months before choosing new ones. If one chooses to not use the names of God that is acceptable also. Simply focus on the spiritual gift(s) that one wants and proceed from there.

## The most powerful spiritual gift

and why and to whom it was given.

Chakra means 'wheel.' They are stationary, spinning, energy centers of the body. I include this information because sometimes, when a gift is strengthened or installed, one can feel it physically. Knowledge of the energy structures of the body might make such a feeling more understandable. Energy moves matter. Strong energy can be physically felt. There are many, many more energy structures of the body but this will suffice. Gifts of the chakras are called chakra siddhi.

The Book of Mormon elaborates on certain of the siddhi that it considers most important. Gifts #1, 47, (130, 132,) etc.

- x Prophecy
- x Revelation

It carries warnings about the gift of prospering in the land when righteous. I am certain that Mormon understood human nature enough to know this would be a sought after gift.

- ◆ Overcoming enemies - gift #14
- ◆ The gift that the three Nephites were blessed with #24, 25, have been known for thousands of years.

These gifts I gathered from the chakra websites before making the connection with the Christian version of spiritual gifts. When I saw the overlap between the two is when I had my "Ah hah!" moment. The siddhi and spiritual gifts are one and the same.

That using fasting and prayer is the stronger, faster, more direct, and safest way of getting spiritual gifts. Christians seek Jesus' face rather than "enlightenment." 9

Building up an arsenal of super powers may allow #20 Witnessing and participating in the pastimes of the gods – small g. But it doesn't land you the best end result. So connecting with Him concerning His gifts seems a better course of action.

I am further guessing that the Nephites who lived happily for over two hundred years got to the point of seeing Jesus' face, maybe having their calling and election made sure. This may be what is meant by this verse:

4 Nephi 1:3 And they had all things common among them; therefore there were not rich and poor, bond and free, but they were all made free, and **partakers of the heavenly gift.**

This may actually be the most powerful spiritual gift!

This may just be Jesus' method we need for having our calling and election made sure.

2 Peter 1:10, ...give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: (D&C 131:5; Mosiah 5:15)

Doctrine and Covenants 53:1-7 1 Behold, I say unto you, my servant Sidney Gilbert, that I have heard your prayers; and you have called upon me that it should be made known unto you, of the Lord your God, concerning your calling and election in the church, which I, the Lord, have raised up in these last days.

2 Behold, I, the Lord, who was crucified for the sins of the world, give unto you a commandment that you shall forsake the world.

7 And again, I would that ye should learn that he only is saved who endureth unto the end. Even so. Amen.

Mosiah 26:20 Thou art my servant; and I covenant with thee that **thou shalt have eternal life**; and thou shalt serve me and go forth in my name, and shalt gather together my sheep.
